Mission Statement

We proclaim that the Caroline Medical Adult Day Care Center is a program of services designed to permit health-impaired adults of Caroline County to remain in their homes and community. They live as independently as possible, with dignity and a renewed sense of quality of life through care in the least restrictive setting. The Caroline Medical Adult Day Care is a service within the continuum of long-term care that prevents inappropriate or premature institutionalization. It is a distinctive service in its approach focus.

The center will approach each person as a unique individual, recognizing strengths, weakness and the potential for growth and development.

The center will assume a holistic approach for each individual, and recognize the inter-relationship among the physical, social, emotional, and environmental aspects of well-being. The center will promote positive attitudes toward self-image, restoration, maintenance and stimulation of capacities for independence while providing supports for functional limitations.

The center team of social worker, nurse and rehabilitative staff will provide a flexible program of services and activities with attention to individual plans of care. It will reduce isolation and prejudice often associated with physical and mental impairments. Caregivers/families of participants are provided respite, counseling, education and a support system.
